

Wolf Day Camp



PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

Participants: This program is for Wolf Scouts rank in June and newly recruited Wolf Cub Scouts.

Locations: The Wolf Day Camp programs are offered at all three of our Cub Camp locations; Kiwanis Scout Camp, Phillippo Scout Camp and Stearns Scout Camp.

Camp Schedule & Program: Camp gates open at 8:30 a.m., check-in runs from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Please try to arrive by 8:30 a.m. When you arrive, have your designated camp leader check-in the whole pack at registration. Activities will end at 9:00 am the following day. Youth participating will go through a series of program rotations where they will participate in camp activities such as archery, bb guns, swimming, nature, crafts and games. Scouts will complete some of the Wolf Adventure requirements throughout the day. In the evening they will have a chance to explore camp and choose between a variety of open activity stations.

Wolf Rank Achievements & Electives: Your Wolf Cub will have the opportunity to work on his 'Call of the Wild', 'Spirit of the Water', 'and Running with the Pack' adventures. Scouts will also have a chance to achieve the Cub Scout Shooting Sports award in archery and bb guns.

Registration Policy: **All youth participants must be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America.** During check-in, camp rosters will be compared to pack charters. Applications must be filled out with the appropriate membership fees paid for all unregistered boys **before** they can participate.

Adult Role at Camp: Each pack must provide one (1) adult leader for one (1) Wolf Cub. The daily adult fee (\$10.00) includes lunch and participation in free time activities. The camp has full time staff members hired to run the events and activities; adult leaders are encouraged to help manage the group of Cubs and volunteer to assist.

Health History Forms: Every Wolf Cub and adult must have a completed health history form. This is not a physical, but simply an informational form to alert the staff of any health problems and to let them know who to notify in case of emergency. **Note: parent signature required to participate in archery. All the health forms should be brought with you to camp. Please DO NOT mail-in to the office or camp.**

Medical Care: Basic first aid is given at the camp by a trained Health Officer. Complete medical services are available at nearby hospitals. **Treatment given outside the camp is a family expense, not that of the camp or BSA.**

Telephone Service: The **Emergency Only** phone number at Kiwanis is 651-433-2801; at Phillippo is 507-263-4324 and Stearns Scout Camp is 320-236-7879.

Food Service: Lunch is provided at camp as part of the Wolf Day Camp fee for adults and youth in the camp's dining facility. Wolf Cubs and adults should bring their own water bottles for use throughout the day. Many special dietary needs can be accommodated with advance notice (i.e. peanut free, gluten/wheat free, vegetarian), contact jnutter@nsbsa.org two weeks prior to attending camp.

Clothing: Uniforms are encouraged for the opening ceremony. Wear clothes comfortable for weather (including rain gear if necessary, all programs are on RAIN OR SHINE and are mainly held outdoors) and suitable active footwear. Hats, sunscreen, and insect repellent are also a good idea. Bring a swim suit and towel for swimming activities.

Trading Post: Wolf Scouts have the opportunity to buy souvenirs, camping equipment, extra camp patches, pop, and candy at the camp Trading Post. (Visa and MasterCard accepted)

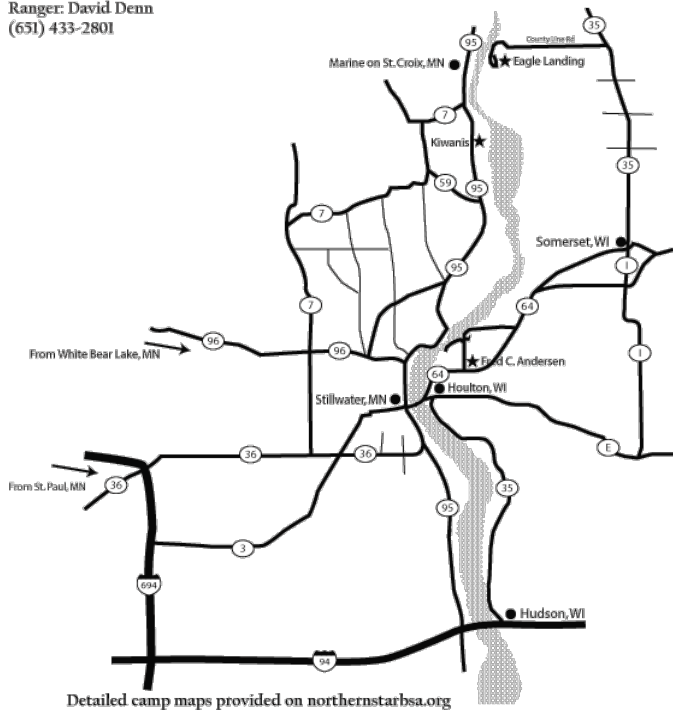

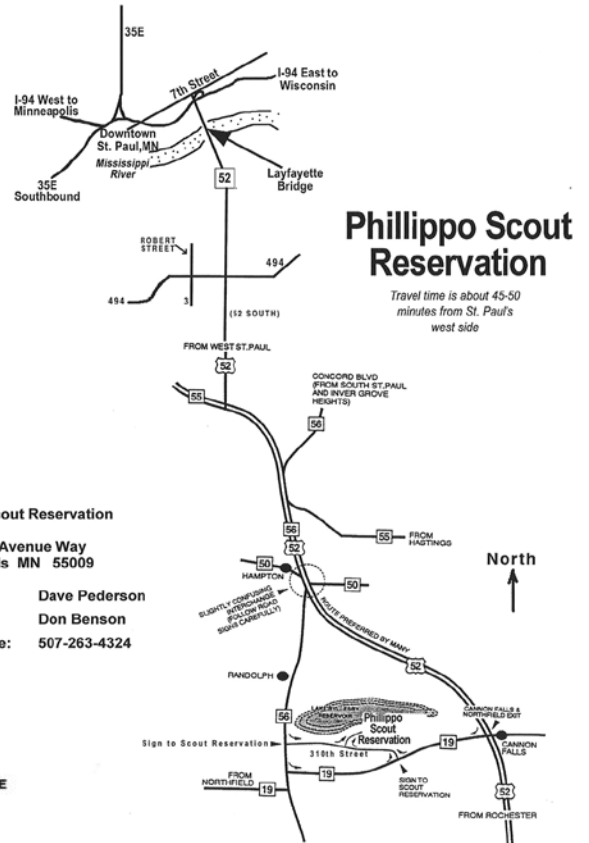
Map to

Detailed camp maps provided on northernstarbsa.org



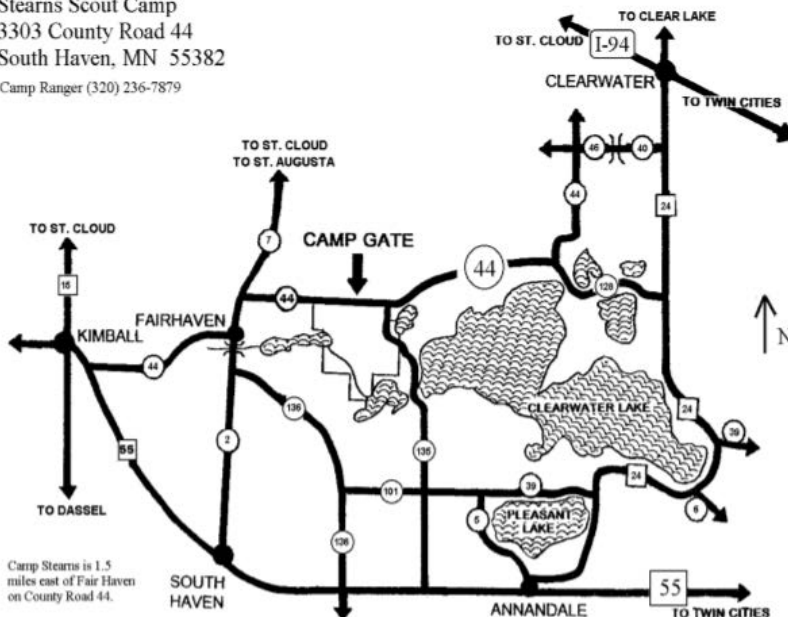
Phillippo Scout Reservation
