PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:	SNOW BASE	NORTH WIND
<p><b>INTRODUCTORY PROGRAM:</b> Teaching youth how to stay warm. Spend the day outside playing games and developing winter camping skills. Participants sleep inside both nights. (Recommended for 5th and 6th graders)</p>	Snow Huskies	Experience
<p><b>NEXT LEVEL:</b> Participants Sleep outside! testing their skills constructing winter shelters and sleeping outside. Campers have the opportunity to earn the zero hero award. (Recommended for 7th grade and up)</p>	Spearhead	Adventure
<p><b>CHALLENGE LEVEL:</b> Winter survival camping. Advanced trek for older Scouts. Recommended for Scouts that have already done Spearhead or Adventure programs. (Recommended for 8th grade and up)</p>	Expedition	Expedition

## Snow Base Featured programs:

### Dog Sledding:

Participants learn how to drive a dogsled pulled by a real team of dogs. Ride and drive the sled. Available select weekends.

(Recommended for 8th grade and up)

### Draft Horse Logging Camp:

Stay in a log cabin heated by a wood stove. Cut up trees with two-person saws and then use the horses to pull them back to camp. Available select weekends, (For (Recommended for 7th grade and up)

## North Wind Featured Programs:

Search and Rescue: A weekend dedicated to search and rescue operations. Scouts are given winter based Search and rescue scenarios. Scouts earn the S.A.R. merit badge.

Snow Sports: All inclusive weekend providing everything needed to earn the Snow Sports Merit Badge, plus all the amenities needed for a weekend stay at North Wind.

Ice Fishing: All-inclusive fishing experience including the latest ice fishing gear used by the pro's, rods, tip ups, bait, heated house, augers, and more. Scouts will earn the fishing merit badge.

Registrations open September 15th

Programs run 8 weekends through January and February.
